News regarding temporary embargo on Interchange Westbound Traffic to Southern California:

Due to the ongoing unresolved labor issues at the West Coast Ports that have resulted in severe port and terminal congestion, the BNSF has implemented a temporary embargo for interchange traffic originating on the eastern railroads destined to Southern California.

This temporary embargo applies only to **westbound** containers originating on the Norfolk Southern or CSX railroads. BNSF direct lanes are not impacted and normal schedules remain in effect.

We have received communication from one carrier, **MSC**, advising they will not accept any further bookings via the West Coast from these origins until the embargo is lifted.
