



**Port Congestion Surcharge for Export Cargo from/via US West Coast
Effective November 17, 2014**

Due to the increased expenses associated with prolonged port congestion and labor issues, Carrier's operating costs have escalated substantially at all US West Coast ports over many months. Therefore, they have chosen to implement the following congestion surcharge that is effective on all cargo moving to or through all USWC ports on or after November 17, 2014.

We are also advised that the FMC is questioning whether the charge can be applied to shipments that have already been received by the carriers either in the USA or overseas. This may delay the implementation of the charge on import cargo or require carriers to refund the charge in the future. For now, the charge is in effect.

Exports:

- USD \$240 per 20'
- USD \$300 per 40'
- USD \$338 per 40' HC
- USD \$380 per 45'

Imports:

- USD \$800/20'
- USD \$1000/40'
- USD \$1125/40' HC

We appreciate your understanding and continued support during these circumstances and look forward to an early return to normal operating conditions.
